And considering the Public Health Emergency declared by Governor John Bel Edwards on March 11, 2020, (25 JBE 2020) and supplemented March 13, 2020 (27 JBE 2020) in response to the multiple confirmed cases of COVID-19 in the State of Louisiana; and further, in consideration of the hazardous and unsafe condition caused therefrom:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all criminal matters scheduled through April 12, 2020, will be given a new court date upon appearing at the BOGALUSA CITY COURT on your regularly set court date. You are still under subpoena and are ordered to appear on your scheduled MONDAY to be re-served for your new court date. You will NOT be placed in the Courtroom or grouped together in any manner. Everyone will be served one person at a time, at the window in the Clerk's Office with appropriate spacing. The Marshal's office will be here to ensure everyone is re-served promptly and safely.

This order does not limit the Court's ability to rule on motions.

IT IS FURTHER HEREBY ORDERED that the following restrictions will be temporarily enforced in each of this Court's courtrooms or offices until it is determined to be safe to remove them:

No admittance will be allowed of any person who has been in any of the following areas within the last 14 days: CHINA, JAPAN, SOUTH KOREA, EUROPE, and IRAN. This list may be updated as further guidance is received.

No admittance will be allowed of any person who resides or has had close contact with someone who has been in one of the above areas in the last 14 days.

No admittance will be allowed of any person who has been asked to self-quarantine by any hospital or agency.

No admittance will be allowed by any person who suspects he/she has contracted or diagnosed, or has have contact with anyone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19.
