KNOW THE FACTS

WHO CAN CARRY NARCAN?

Anyone can carry Narcan in Louisiana thanks to the Standing Order.

WHO SHOULD CARRY NARCAN?

- ANYONE that received prescription pain medication
- ANYONE that suffers from addiction to any substance (many NON opioid drugs are now testing positive for Fentanyl)
- ANYONE that knows someone struggling with addiction
- ANYONE that wants to help save a life

WHAT IS AN OPIOID?

Opioids are drugs like prescription pain pills (Vicodin, Percocet, oxycodone, etc), heroin, and fentanyl.

WHAT DOES AN OVERDOSE LOOK LIKE?

Unresponsive, blue lips/ fingernails, slow OR no breathing, choking/ gurgling sound in their throat.

HOW DO I USE NARCAN?

NASAL SPRAY - Use in 3 steps:

- 1** Identify overdose and check for response
- 2** One spray Narcan into nose, will release a full dose. (Do NOT prime nasal spray.)
- 3** Call 911 ALWAYS

It is important to keep the person in the recovery position between administering doses. You can give as many doses as they need at 90-120 second intervals. You can also download the Narcan Now App for a demonstration.

WHERE CAN I GET NARCAN?

Most pharmacies keep Narcan in stock. You do NOT need a prescription. If you have insurance, you just need to walk in and ask. If you do not have insurance, you can contact Heather Gernold with FPHSA for a FREE sample: 985-543-4730 ext.1206

WHAT IF I USE IT ON SOMEONE NOT EXPERIENCING AN OVERDOSE?

If someone is not overdosing on opioids, Narcan will have no effect on them.
